Getting there & onsite transport:	New Chitose is Sapporo's international airport, located approximately 45 kilometres from Sapporo city centre. JR (Japan Railway) is the fastest means of transportation to Sapporo City. The Rapid Airport to Sapporo train runs approximately every 15 minutes (except early morning and late night) from 08:00 to 22:00 and takes passengers from the airport to Sapporo Station in just over 30 minutes. The easiest way to get from hotels around Sapporo to the venue is by using the city's subway system. The nearest subway station to the venue is Tsukisamu-Chuo station (月寒中央駅) on the Toho (blue) Line.
